We Observe and Uphold the Human Rights Code

Our Commitment to Human Rights

It is public policy in Ontario to recognize the dignity and worth of every person and to provide for equal rights and opportunities without discrimination that is contrary to law.

The *Human Rights Code* provides for equal treatment in the areas of service, goods and facilities, accommodation, contracts, employment, and membership in vocational associations and trade unions without discrimination on the grounds of race, ancestry, place of origin, colour, ethnic origin, citizenship, creed, sex (including pregnancy), sexual orientation, disability, and family status, marital status (including same-sex partnership), the receipt of public assistance (in accommodation only), and record of offences (in employment only).

The *Code* provides for freedom from harassment or other unwelcome comments and actions in employment, services and accommodation on all of the grounds.

It is the privilege and responsibility of every person in Ontario to honour and adhere to the letter and the spirit of the *Code*, and to support its aim of creating a climate of understanding and mutual respect for the dignity and rights of each individual.

We recognize that this applies to all employers, employees, employment agencies, trade unions, professional associations, landlords, tenants, realtors, those entering into a contract and those providing goods, services and facilities.
